

Placing the livestock classes were nationally known judges Dan Moser and Twig Marston, both from the Kansas State University staff. In the Bull Division, Kansas exhibitors were Brooke and Brady Jensen, Audrey Hambright, James Preuss and Tyler Cowan. Each of them had a class winner. Taking home the top honors was Brady Jensen with KJ BJ Bounty Hunter 741P.

Twenty-eight Kansas steers owned by twenty-five juniors paraded before Judge Dan Moser. Talking home class winner awards were: Katie Jo Parks, Brooke Jensen, Josh Roady, Brandy Valek, Danny Koons and Courtney Schultz. Reserve Champion Steer went to Danny Koons.

In the Ultra Sounding, Allie Will was champion with Brook Schultz reserve. Of the top 10 animals, nine were Kansas steers.

Brooke Jensen took home the top award for Kansas in the Cow/ Calf Pair Division. Her cow CRR D03 Kay Baby 204 with a February bull calf at side was named the reserve of the show. Tara Ellerman and Robert Craig exhibited other Kansas pairs.

Eleven Kansas Bred & Owned heifers were presented. Earning first places were Cody Pieper, Justin Brown and Alex Acheson.

In the Owned Heifer Division ranked by Judge Marston, fiftythree horned and polled Kansas heifers were exhibited. Class winners were: Cody Pieper, Dylan Evans and Brady Jensen. Dylan Evans' Class 13 winner, KJ 2403 Huntress 854P was also named Division III Polled and overall Champion Heifer. Brady Jensen's February, Class 10 winner, KJ C&L J119 Enchantment 810P was named Polled Division IV Champion.

3 on 3 Basketball was the first competitive event of the three days. Three divisions were coordinated and managed by former junior, Kim Stump Schmidt. Kansas Teams took all three second places. In the Pee Wees team members were: Brooke Jensen, Bailey McKay and Miranda Stotz of Oklahoma; Junior members were Brady Jensen, Jake Valek and Kyla Woolfolk; and the Seniors were BJ Valek, Justin Brown and Danny Koons. There were a total of 16 teams competing.

Bill Disberger, Judging Coach of Hutchinson Juco graciously agreed to put on the judging contest. Placing highest for the Kansas kids was: Pee Wee Brooke Jensen, 1st, Seth McKay 3rd, Wade Hambright 4th, and Bailey McKay 5th. The team of Bailey, Seth and Brooke won that division. Juniors: Cody Jensen 1st, Jacob Valek 2nd, Charlsie Craig 3rd, Brady Jensen 4th and that team was first place for that division. The Valek girls, Mandi and Robin placed the highest in the Senior Division. They were ranked 3rd and 5th with their team placing first.

In the Showmanship Contest four age divisions were ranked 1st through 5th by Judge Moser. Pee Wee Champion was Brooke Jensen with Seth McKay being 5th. After four heats of Juniors, Taylor Davis was named Champion with Tara Ellerman 4th and Brady Jensen 5th. Audrey Hambright was named the senior division with Brandy Valek placing 5th




Yes, the weather and the facilities were in our favor, but countless remarks were made to me about enjoying the show and the hospitality that the Kansas folks offered.

Please excuse my informality of this and except my genuine thank you to all of you.






