- The show will be a NO FIT. This means no glue or adhesive of any kind can be used.
- 2) Every Hereford steer needs to have a Certified Steer Certificate issued by the American Hereford Association (AHA). It must be the official copy, not a photocopy.

Note: Because the show date conflicts with the AHA national tour, do not expect someone from Kansas City to be able to bring papers to the show.


